Preventing choking injuries in children: a key role to play for the Latin-American community

The SusySafe project is back with two workshops entitled "Preventing choking injuries in children: a key role to play for the Latin-American community". The first was held on the 1st September in Rosario, Argentina, during the 32nd congress of otorhinolaryngology. nized in collaboration with the AFP-Asociacion Argentina de Otorrinolaringología y fonoaudiologia pediatrica and under the patronage of the Italian Embassy in Argentina, the meeting resulted in the active participation of many doctors

and authority from Italy and Argentina. The roundtable was opened with the introduction of Eng. Gabriele Paparo, science attaché to Italian Embassy, which supported the project and the scientific cooperation between Italy and Argentina with immense success. Dr. Peppino Grande, Italian vice-consul and Dr. Alejandro Ceccato, deputy minister of the Ministry of Science, Technology and Productive Innovation in Argentina were also presented. Prof. Da-Gregori introduced rio data collected in the last

years, with a relevant attention to the activities conducted in Argentina, at the present time active with 15 researching centers, with the cooperation of otolaryngologists and surgeons. Excellent example of the synergistic cooperation of Susy Safe project and South America is the collaboration with Prof. Hugo Rodriguez, head of the department of respiratory endoscopy in the pediatric hospital Juan P. Garrahan (Buenos Aires) and group, group, Dr. Magdalena Roquez, Dr. Giselle Cuestas,











Dr. Susana Tortosa, Dr. Bibiana Paoli, Dr. Hugo Botto and Dr. Alberto Iñón, who shared their knowledge with foreign bodies and accident prevention and implemented the database with many data and their experience. The second workshop was held on the 3rd September 2012 at the Italian Cultural Institute (ICI) of San Paolo (Brazil). There as well, the Susy Safe project found the endorsement of the Italian Embassy, enthusiastic participant at the event. Dr. Giovanni Sacco, chief of ICE - Italian Institute for Foreign Trade in Sao Paulo, have actively collaborated with Susy Safe staff to organize and promote the meeting. Among the speakers Prof. Dario Gregori, Dr. Hugo Rodriguez, Dr. Dayse Manrique, coordinator of otorhinolaryngology clinic of the AACD-Associacao de Assistencia a Crianca Deficiente in Brazil, Dr. Juliana Alves de Sousa, Dr. Juliana Sato Hermann and Dr. Paschoal Napolitano. The two roundtables focused the attention to the gravity and increasing number of accidents and demonstrated, in front of a qualified institutional representation, how this international group is a point of absolute reference for foreign body injuries in Latin-America. The research on Preventing Foreign Bodies Injuries in children has been approved within the framework of the Executive Programme for 2011-2013 of the Agreement of Cultural, Scientific and Technological Cooperation between Italy and Argentina, signed in 1997 by the General Directorate for Cultural Cooperation of the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MAE) and the Ministry of Science, Tecnology and Industrial Innovation of Argentina (Ministerio de Ciencia, Tecnología e Innovación Productiva - MINCYT) for the 3-years period 2011-2013. Susy Safe is an official project supported by the Directorate-General of the European commission and enjoys a Permament European Commission Endorsement.
